Guidelines for Manuscript Submissions

Contributions should be original scholarly work that has not been published previously and has not been simultaneously submitted to other journals for publication. Articles should include an abstract of not more than 150 words, written in English, that clearly defines the thesis of the work. Please include the full address of the author, including e-mail address, and the title of the work on a separate title page. Manuscripts should ordinarily be between 6000-8000 words, but may be no longer than 10,000 words (excluding notes, tables, and abstract).

All papers submitted to JHRE will be assessed through a double-blind peer review. All accepted manuscripts are subject to editorial modification.

Please send all submissions in electronic form via e-mail attachment to jhreditors@gmail.com. To ensure that we can read the attachment, please send all manuscripts in Microsoft Word or RTF format only. (For those who are unable to send their manuscripts electronically, please send two paper copies, double spaced, to the snail-mail address below.)
